Nursery Class

In nursery this term, we will be asking the question "Where will our imagination take us?"

After the Christmas holidays, the children returned to the classroom to find a large sparkly shell in the sand. The children spent their first day wondering: Who the shell belonged too? Whose home could it be? And trying to guess their new project.

The next day the children came into class to find their key question had been put on the wall. Then they had a surprise visit from a crab who had moved into the shell.

This in turn opened a discussion on the artist JMW Turner and his stormy sea paintings.
