

YEAR GROUP UPDATE

Year 3

New uniform policy

Please remember that our new uniform policy comes into effect in September this year. Don't forget to order your polo shirts if you need them from our [uniform supplier](#) in plenty of time.

Please can I also remind you that smart watches are not allowed in school.
